I, the undersigned YARDLEY Andrea, born on 24 December 1971 in Calgary, Canada, domiciled in Mala'e, declare that I am acting as an expert appointed by Mr ANGIBAUD, the examining magistrate, and that I took the oath on 18 December 2020 in Mata Utu. I certify that I took possession, on that same day, of the file containing two seals as well as photocopies of the logbook of the vessel Zulu Time. After inspection, I was able to see that the two seals were integrated. As document 19/TIC was an open seal, the document could be processed without the seal being broken. I proceeded to open the second seal, document 31/TIC, in order to carry out the translation.

In view of the information followed for the worrying disappearance of Messrs ABDUL RASHED SHUKREE, HASSAN DAWOUD and CALVIN ISAAC-FERRIS DANIAN, since 28 November 2020 in Wallis;

Having regard to Articles 18 (paragraph 4), 80-4, 74, 74-1, 92 to 108, 151 et seq., D 12 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 156 to 169-1 of the Code of Criminal Procedure;

Given the urgency;

In view of the impossibility of **having** recourse to an expert translator in English language registered on the list of experts of the Court of Appeal of Noumea,

Let us commission Mrs. YARDLEY Andrea, married LIKUVALU, English teacher, of Canadian nationality, residing in Malae, 98600 MATA UTU, as an expert, who shall, prior to his operations, swear an oath in writing to perform his mission in his honor and conscience, to fulfill the mission hereinafter indicated.

Let's say that the expert will submit a detailed report containing his reasoned opinion and a certificate that he has personally fulfilled the mission entrusted to him as soon as possible.

Let us recall, moreover, that in application of article R I 07 of the code of criminal procedure, when the anticipated amount of his expenses and fees exceeds 460€ (54,893 CFP francs), the designated expert must, before beginning his work, inform the court that appointed him.

- 2° - Translate from English to French the documents under the two seals mentioned above, as well as the pages of the logbook of the ship Zulu Time, numbered 12-13, 16-17, 19 to 24, 26-27, 29 to 35;

Let's say that the expert will be allowed to reconstruct the seals after the expertise operations; In general, make any observations relevant to the research covered by this procedure and record your observations in a report.

The expert shall submit, as soon as possible, a detailed report signed by him and mentioning the names and qualifications of the persons who may have assisted him, under his supervision and responsibility, in the to carry out the operations deemed necessary by him for the execution of the mission entrusted to him, in accordance with Article 166 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

In view of the urgency and impossibility of postponing the expertise operations and the filing of the conclusions for a period of ten days, the expertise operations may begin without deadline ;
