I come back to you concerning the worrying disappearance in Wallis, on November 28, 2020, of two nationals of American nationality, namely :

ABDUL-RASHED SHUKREE, HASSAN DAWOUD born on 03 04 1994

CALVIN ISAAC-FERRIS DANIAN born 08 03 2000

The search for them has been unsuccessful so far, which makes the hypothesis of their drowning in the Wallis lagoon the most likely one.

Upon further investigation, the investigator determined that Calvin's mother was Abigail FERRIS-DANIAN and would have an active facebook account that would allow you to contact her in order to inform her of the procedure in progress at her office.

As for ABDUL RASHED SHUKREE, he would also appear on social networks as a husband.

For all intents and purposes, I am attaching the results of the investigator's inquiries on these social networks and thank you in advance for keeping me informed of any contact details of their family members that you may obtain. Sincerely

Dear colleague, liaison magistrate,

I have received a complaint concerning the disturbing disappearance in Wallis, on 28 November 2020, of two American nationals, namely:

ABDUL-RASHED SHUKREE, HASSAN DAWOUD born on 03 04 1994 (believed to be born in New York, married with no children, about to obtain a PhD in chemistry)

CALVIN ISAAC-FERRIS DANIAN born 08 03 2000 (reportedly contacted his mother, grandmother and aunt after arriving by air in Hawaii and before boarding the sailing vessel Zulu Time in Honolulu for Rarotonga, Cook Islands, who were not seen again after the sailing boat "ZULU TIME" entered the Wallis Iagoon, despite the searches and investigations carried out on site since the alert.

Within the framework of this procedure of research of the causes and circumstances of these disappearances, the members of their family or their close relations, have the possibility of constituting civil parties between my hands, and to profit from the rights which are attached to it (access to the file, request for acts...).

That is why I had contacted the American consulate in Fiji, so that their family and friends could be informed of my referral and that I could have their contact details to inform them of their rights in the context of such a procedure or that they could be informed by the consulate.

As I have not had any positive feedback from the consuls with whom the following emails were exchanged, I would like to ask you to do so and thank you in advance for your diligence, given that to date the research and investigations carried out have been unsuccessful.

At the request of our consul in charge, I am sending you a reply to France based on the verbal feedback that he has given me.

Searches went up to the central file.

As for your request for contact information for the families, we have no information on Abdul. He does not appear in any files. For Calvin, we have nothing more than what appears on the permit. Unfortunately, we will not be of much help.

Do you think they are dead? 7 Is it possible that they are just fugitives hiding in the wild? 7 Do you have any clues about their fate?
